## The following Boil Water Notice is **RESCINDED**

As of August 9, 2018

### BOIL WATER NOTIFICATION

System ID #026002

Due to a water leak after a fire hydrant was struck by a car, the City of Somerville as a Community Public Water System hereby notifies all customers to boil their water prior to consumption as required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

Children, seniors and persons with weakened immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria and all customers should follow these directions.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes. The water should be brought to a vigorous boil and then boiled for two minutes.

In lieu of boiling, individuals may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

When it is no longer necessary to boil water, the public water system officials will notify customers that the water is safe for drinking water or human consumption.

Once the boil water notice is no longer in effect, the public water system will issue a notice to customers that rescinds the boil water notice similar to this notice.
