Description

The purpose of the position is to complete a variety of tasks in the construction, maintenance and repair of streets, sidewalks and storm drains. This includes removing debris, patching streets, replacing signage, mowing and weedeating parks and right of way, use of various city equipment, repairing water and sewer lines and other duties as assigned.

Duties

>Performs a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled labor tasks in order to maintain streets, roadway, storm sewers, water and sewer lines, parks and other city infrastructure. Duties vary according to job assignment and individual skills.

>Performs manual labor tasks in resurfacing, patching, sweeping, grading and shaping roads, digs and fills holes, clears and repairs roadway, clears trash, brush, weeds and debris from roadways.

>Assists in repairing water and sewer lines

>Cleans and maintains City buildings and facilities

>Follows safety rules and regulations

>Learns to operate a variety of equipment

Minimum Qualifications

Ten years of construction or maintenance experience: OR an equivalent combination of education, training and experience. High School Diploma or GED.

>Valid Texas Class C Drivers License. Prefer valid Texas CDL or the ability to obtain with 12 months of employment.
